- 3. Palestinian Arabs oppose Jewish Settlement

2. Partition and War

- 3. 1947 UN Suggests Palestine Partitioned Arab/Jew---Refuse
- 3. 1948 Jews announce creation of Israel
- 3. Arabs refuse to recognize state & declare war---Israel Wins

2. Palestinian Refugees

- 3. 500,000 Arabs driven out of Palestine
- 3. Live in Refugee Camps for Decades

2. Background

- 3. 1956 - Israel, Britain & France vs. Egypt over Suez Canal
- 3. 1967 - Six Day War Arabs vs. Israelis --- Israelis Win Sinai, Gaza, West Bank
- 3. 1973 - Syria & Egypt vs. Israel Israel wins again

2. Superpower Involvement

- 3. U.S. Backs Israel - Soviets Back Arabs during Cold War
- 3. Both sides refuse to make concessions --- could trigger war

2. The PLO

- 3. Occupied territory -- land seized by Israel during 6 day
- 3. Palestine Liberation Organization formed to reclaim Palestine
- 3. 1970s the PLO committed terrorist acts against Israeli supporters
- 3. Reprisals - forced acts in response to injury
- 3. 1982 Israel invades Lebanon to fight PLOs

2. The People

- 3. 90% live in urban areas along Mediterranean coast
- 3. Ashkenazim Jews (Eastern & Central Europe) vs Sephardim (Med & ME)
- 3. Ashkenazim dominate govt first but Sephardim now
- 3. 15% of Israelis are non-Jews (Arab Muslims & Christians)

3. 1979 Egypt & Israel sign peace treaty

3. Egypt is first Arab nation to recognize Israel

2. A Palestinian Uprising

3. 1987 Intifada (shaking) Palestinians attack Israelis

3. Israel fights back kill rebels destroy homes close Arab Schools

3. During Intifada some Palestinians join terrorist groups Hamas & Islamic Jihad
